Senior Letter - Graduation Cap & Gowns

All graduates/potential graduates are encouraged to participate in the graduation ceremony. Students may either purchase and keep, or borrow and return, a cap and gown. A senior letter will be MAILED by the first week of February to all graduates/potential graduates with more information.
