### **Field Trip to Modesto Jr. College WEST CAMPUS, Friday, November 18th**

Any interested 11th or 12th grader is welcome to attend, we will take up to 50 students. Students will be observing various certificate programs, touring the campus and having a question and answer session with MJC outreach staff members. Signed permission slips must be returned by Wednesday, November 16th. All students will ride a school bus from Argus/Endeavor leaving at 8:40 am (arrive at school by 8:30 am) and returning by 11:30 am.

### **Free Application for Federal Student Aid – [www.fafsa.ed.gov](http://www.fafsa.ed.gov)**

The FAFSA application period is open and is the first step in the financial aid process. Use it to apply for federal and state student financial aid, such as grants, student loans, and college work-study. All potential high school graduates (or those that will earn a GED) are encouraged to submit a FAFSA.

### **FSA ID (Electronic signature) for the FAFSA - [www.fsaid.ed.gov](http://www.fsaid.ed.gov).**

If this is your first time filling out the FAFSA, and you haven't applied for an FSA ID, you should do so now. Your FSA ID is what allows you to complete the FAFSA; you use your FSA ID to electronically sign your application. You'll also need your FSA ID to make online corrections to your FAFSA, including changing your name and address, or adding/changing the name of a school to receive your application data. If you are a dependent student, also get an FSA ID for your parent.

### **2017-2018 MJC Scholarships**

Modesto Jr. College is now accepting scholarship applications for the 17-18 school year. The deadline to apply is December 16, 2016. Applicants must have an active MJC college email account (@student.yosemite.edu) Current high school seniors can apply now for admission to MJC.
