Free Application for Federal Student Aid – www.fafsa.ed.gov

The FAFSA application period is open and is the first step in the financial aid process. Use it to apply for federal and state student financial aid, such as grants, student loans, and college work-study. All potential high school graduates (or those that will earn a GED) are encouraged to submit a FAFSA.

FSA ID (Electronic signature) for the FAFSA - www.fsaid.ed.gov.

If this is your first time filling out the FAFSA, and you haven't applied for an FSA ID, you should do so now. Your FSA ID is what allows you to complete the FAFSA; you use your FSA ID to electronically sign your application. You'll also need your FSA ID to make online corrections to your FAFSA, including changing your name and address, or adding/changing the name of a school to receive your application data. If you are a dependent student, also get an FSA ID for your parent.

Modesto Jr. College is now accepting scholarship applications for the 17-18 school year. For priority consideration the deadline is November 1, 2016. The final deadline to apply is December 16, 2016. Applicants must have an active MJC college email (@student.yosemite.edu) Current high school seniors can apply now for admission to MJC.
